Still, there is great value in carrying out preparation and practice with a clear goal in mind, even if the desired result does not come. Even as we move towards Sports Day, we must make sure they carry with them their own personal goals, and lead them through the process of achieving those goals in order for our students to become independent and self-reliant.

Therefore, for the benefit of the children's effective development on Sports Day, we request support and encouragement from home.
